Market Hours & Days of Operation: The Farmer's Market is held at The Pizza Place on Wednesdays from June 5th, 2024 through September 25th, 2024. Operating hours are 4:00p.m.— 6:00p.m. The Pizza Place is located at 126 Franklin St, Center Point, IA.

Code of Conduct: The City of Center Point may, at its discretion, close any vendor stall for any fraudulent, dishonest and deceptive practices, inappropriate conduct, activities or otherwise disturbing the peace by the vendor, or its employees, agents or representatives on the premises. Display or sale of obscene, illegal or unsafe merchandise is prohibited, the determination of which is at the discretion of the City staff. The Farmer's Market is a No Smoking Area.

Live Animals: No live animals can be sold at the market. Vendors are not permitted to have pets with them at the Market. Exceptions to this policy are made for service animals.

Set Up Policies: Set up begins each Wednesday no earlier than 3:00pm. Do not start selling until 4:00pm to be fair to all buyers. Farmers will need to provide their own tables for set up; tables must be no larger than a total of 8 feet ensuring plenty of space for all vendors. There is a \$4.00 fee per market, per vendor. Fees are used to help cover advertising expenses to promote the market.

Clean Up Policies: All vendors must clean up their area before leaving the Market.

Payment Options

\$4.00 per market (must be paid on or prior to arrival)

Or

\$48.00 for all 17 markets (\$20.00 in savings)

Or

\$40.00 for 13 market dates of your choice (\$12.00 in savings)

Fee Information

In order to be a vendor at the Center Point Farmers Market payment must be made to the City of Center Point. Payment can be cash or check and is to be placed in a city drop box at Center Point Foods or City Hall, or can be given in-person to a staff member at City Hall during the hours of 8am – 4pm Monday – Thursday and 8am – 12pm on Friday. Payment can also be mailed to PO Box 299, Center Point IA, 52213. Payment must be made prior to selling anything at the market. In the event a vendor is caught selling at market without paying they will be asked to leave and will be banned from attending future markets. Fees collected will be used by the Parks & Recreation Department to help promote and grow the Farmers Market. This may include new signage, boosted Facebook posts, and special events.

Indemnity Agreement

Agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Center Point and its employee and officers from and against all liability claims, damages, demands, causes of action, suits or judgments for death, injury or damage to persons or property, whether directly or indirectly, arising out of or in connection with concessionaire's use of the premises or the intended use thereof from all liability claims arising out of: the actions of myself, my employees, agents and helpers at the Farmer's Market; items brought to the Farmer's Market (including vehicles, booth materials, umbrellas); items sold at the Farmer's Market; and other liability except that arising out of the sole negligence of the City of Center Point. By signing this agreement, I certify that I have received a copy of the Farmers Markets Requirements from Inspections & Appeals Food and Consumer Safety Bureau and will comply with them.
