Garbage Collection

Garbage collection is provided by Rudd Sanitation. P: 319-438-6563

Thursday: Franklin St, both sides and all dead ends off of Franklin, including E Green St and the entire West side of town.
Friday: The entire East side of town, east of Franklin St.

Please set your garbage & recycling out the night before your pickup day.

- Each resident is allowed 1 (35lb) garbage can or bag per week. This can, cannot weigh over 40lbs. Extra garbage cans or bags must have a waste tag attached.
- Waste tags can be purchased for \$1 (cash only) at The City Hall, The Corner Store, or Caseys (only Center Point Rd location).
- Trash/Recycling costs are included in your city water bill.

City Council

The City Council meets the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month at 6:00 pm in the Council Chambers located at 200 Franklin St.



Water Bills

Utility Bills are mailed monthly. They are sent out by the 1st of the month and due by the 15th. If the 15th lands on a weekend, bills are due the following Monday.

Compost Site

The Compost Site is an area that citizens may drop off their yard waste, such as branches, grass clippings, etc. There is also compost, wood chips, and mulch available to citizens. This facility is only for residents that live within city limits. There is a code needed to enter the area, you will find the code on your water bill.

The City of Center Point holds Clean Up Days for the citizens during the Spring and Fall at the Compost Site.

Snow Removal

The snow plowing/ice control policy will be in effect when:

- The city has 2 inches of accumulation on the emergency routes (Franklin St, Lewis Access Rd, Grubbs St, Central Ave, N. Center Point Rd, Green St, Main St, Washington St, E. 1st St, Palo Rd, Rosedale Dr. Iowa St, Valley St and Ford Ln.) and snow is continuing to fall.
- Failure to move vehicles from ANY city street while under a Snow Emergency, within 24 hours, may result in a ticket being issued.
- Citizens have 48 hours, from when the snow emergency ends, to clear their sidewalks.
- Private snow movers may not push snow from private property onto City streets or anywhere else snow is designated for removal by the City crews.

Golf Cart Permits

Golf carts are permitted on certain City streets from March 1st to November 30th. Permits are REQUIRED to drive on the streets. **Drivers must be 18 years of age.** Golf cart permits are \$25 and can be picked up at City Hall. Please bring your drivers license and proof of insurance.
